Upcycling Workshop: Salt Lanterns from Jars

This year, attendees will take part in the upcycling workshop "The Second Life of Packaging – Salt Lanterns from Jars". The activity will demonstrate how everyday waste can be transformed into functional and decorative objects, showing that discarded materials are valuable resources rather than useless trash. This hands-on experience is not just a fun craft session, but also a lesson in circular economy, where waste is repurposed rather than discarded.

Recycling in Fashion: Exhibition of Upcycled Headwear

At the eco-manager's booth, visitors can explore a post-competition exhibition showcasing recycled headwear designed by participants of the "Don't Burn It - Design It! Contest for an Eco-Friendly Headpiece". This initiative raises awareness of the impact of waste burning on air quality while proving that fashion and sustainability can go hand in hand.

The event will also address the environmental impact of the fashion industry, focusing on textile overproduction and the consequences of improper disposal. The exhibition and workshops will highlight the importance of mindful shopping and responsible consumption, which help reduce waste and minimize pollution.
