DESCRIPTION:

ECOINDUSTRIA is a supra-municipal project launched in 2016, co-led by the municipalities of the Llobregat Delta—Viladecans, El Prat, Gavà, Sant Boi, and Castelldefels. Its main objective is to provide direct support to industrial companies in these municipalities to initiate and/or consolidate their transition toward a circular economy, positioning the Delta region (Llobregat river delta) as a benchmark in this field.

Ecoindustria works to support a transition from a linear production model toward an economic and industrial model based on the principles of the circular economy. This model promotes the efficiency of production systems, encourages the use of products, materials, and resources that remain in use for as long as possible, and aims to minimize the amount of waste generated. All of this is approached with a vision of achieving economic growth that enhances business performance, improves societal well-being, and ensures the preservation and regeneration of natural capital.

One of the key lines of action within the project is the organization of **participatory workshops with companies and local stakeholders**, addressing specific topics that help industrial businesses implement circular business models.

These workshops aim to:

- Build capacity, provide training and information, and drive change toward the implementation of circular projects and solutions.
- Foster collaborations and networking opportunities to enable or facilitate this transition.
- Identify circular economy opportunities within the territory.

As part of EU Green Week 2025, we propose holding one specific workshop on **“Opportunities for Industrial Symbiosis in the Delta Area”**

Main objectives of the workshop:

- To understand the strategic and regulatory framework at the European level regarding the circular economy, with a particular focus on industrial symbiosis.
- To identify and define opportunities and solutions for industrial symbiosis in the Delta region.
- To scale up some of the identified initiatives related to symbiosis and waste
