Workshop Series “A School Full of Energy”

The initiative is an official EU Green Week Partner Event.

Where does electricity come from and how can we use it responsibly? During the workshop series “School Full of Energy”, primary school students will learn the basics of how the energy system works and discover why saving energy and developing renewable energy sources are important elements of climate protection and a modern economy.

The meetings, designed for students in grades 4–6, will take the form of interactive educational activities. At the beginning, participants will learn what energy is, where electricity comes from and what the differences are between traditional and renewable energy sources. Solutions such as solar, wind and hydropower will be presented in an accessible way, along with their role in reducing pollution emissions and building a more sustainable energy system.

An important part of the workshops will be hands-on experiments and demonstrations. Students will assemble educational kits showing how wind, water and solar energy work, allowing them to see in practice how energy can be generated from renewable sources. This active participation helps them better understand the principles behind modern energy technologies.

During the sessions, students will also explore how to save energy in everyday life, both at home and at school. Together they will identify places in the classroom where electricity consumption can be reduced and learn about simple habits that help lower energy use. This will show participants that even small actions can have a real impact on the environment and the climate.

The workshops will conclude with an energy quiz, which will reinforce the knowledge gained in an engaging and interactive way. Students will learn that responsible energy use is an important element of building an environmentally friendly economy and caring for air quality and the future of our planet.

The workshop “School Full of Energy” demonstrates that investing in nature begins with knowledge and conscious decisions. Through education, the youngest participants learn how to use energy wisely and how their everyday choices can support a more sustainable future.
