Context

As Europe begins preparing its post-2028 policy framework, this workshop will explore how European indexes and policy tools can evolve to better address inequalities linked to the green and twin transitions.

The event builds on the findings of the [ST4TE project](#), which develops a comprehensive understanding of the drivers behind the twin transition, the inequalities it may create or deepen, and a set of recommendations to help build greener, fairer, and more productive societies.

Discussions will focus on the **Twin Transition Index** developed by the ST4TE project. The session will highlight its added value and examine how it can support the design and coordination of European, national, and regional policies, contributing to the objectives of the European Green Deal.
