Date: Sunday, June 23rd, 2024

Time: 9:30 AM - 12:30 PM

Location: Perama Beach, Greece

9:30 AM - 9:45 AM: Registration and Welcome

- Participants gather at the designated meeting point on Perama Beach.
- Registration and distribution of event materials.
- Welcome address from organizers, highlighting the importance of the cleanup effort and introducing the program.

9:45 AM - 10:00 AM: Safety Briefing and Instructions

- Overview of safety guidelines for beach cleanup activities.
- Instructions on waste management procedures, including garbage sorting and disposal.
- Distribution of gloves, bags, and other cleanup equipment.

10:00 AM - 11:00 AM: Beach Cleanup Activity

- Participants form teams and head to assigned cleanup areas along the beach.
- Engage in thorough cleaning, collecting litter and debris from the shoreline.

11:00 AM - 11:30 AM: Garbage Sorting and Data Collection

- Set up garbage sorting stations for categorizing collected items (plastics, glass, metals, organics, etc.).

 Record data on types and quantities of waste collected for future analysis and advocacy efforts.

11:30 AM - 12:00 PM: Educational Sessions

- Interactive sessions on environmental conservation and marine pollution.
- Presentations or demonstrations on the impact of litter on coastal ecosystems.
- Discussions on sustainable practices and ways to reduce marine pollution.

12:00 PM - 12:15 PM: Closing Ceremony

- Reflection on the cleanup efforts and accomplishments.
- Recognition of participants' contributions and dedication.
- Sharing of insights and personal experiences from the cleanup activity.

12:15 PM - 12:30 PM: Refreshments and Community Bonding

- Participants gather for light refreshments and snacks.
- Informal networking and community bonding opportunities.
- Closing remarks from organizers, thanking participants for their commitment to environmental stewardship.
