10:00 - INTERACTIVE WORKSHOPS FOR KIDS

Kids from local summer camps will participate to an educational workshop focused on nurturing an understanding and appreciation for saving water, maintaining water quality, and enjoying wetlands responsibly. The aim is to spark thoughtful discussions on how human behaviors affect water use and to encourage students to be mindful of their ecological footprint – the mark each one leaves on the planet with our everyday actions.

17:00 - GUIDED WALKING TOUR

Begin with a guided walking tour around the lagoon to delve into its ecological significance, habitats, biodiversity, threats, and the transformative technologies being implemented. This immersive tour is designed to provide participants with a firsthand understanding of this vital water ecosystem and the ongoing and future challenges and adaptation measures to climate change impacts.

18:30 - CHILL-OUT PRESENTATIONS & APERITIF

The evening continues with chill-out presentations that blend naturalistic photography from the Pond of San Giovanni with discussions on ecological threats and the solutions being applied into the TransformAr project using posters and images. As part of this session, students from the Faculty of Architecture of Cagliari, will share the outcomes of the international workshop on architecture and landscape 'Costa Produttiva', focused on the unique ecosystem of the Marceddì lagoon. Accompanied by an aperitif featuring local specialties, this session is an opportunity to learn in a relaxed atmosphere, fostering a deeper connection with our environmental mission.
