recycled containers

• Water Cycle Experiments: Simple outdoor experiments demonstrating water

purification and reuse

• Composting Adventure: Learning how food waste transforms into valuable soil

Participants will understand basic circular economy principles, develop environmental awareness, and learn practical sustainability skills they can apply at home and school. Through playful discovery, children will connect with nature while developing an appreciation for resource conservation.
