In 2023, the European Economic and Social Committee released its call for an EU Blue Deal while Water Europe envisions a Water-Smart Society in which the value of water is recognised and realised to ensure water security, sustainability, and resilience.

After a keynote speech presenting the main findings of EESC opinion on Industrial and technological approaches and best practices supporting a water resilient society and a presentation of the Water-Smart Society, the panel discussion will aim to debate about the tools and good practices to build a water-smart economy in Europe.

A water strategy for industries could secure water for their activities and turns water as competitive asset for them contributing to European water-resiliency and strategic autonomy, thanks to adequate financial support and access to skilled workers.
