Overview on water management in agriculture and food production

The workshop on Water Management in Agriculture and Food aims to address the critical challenges posed by water scarcity and inefficiency in agriculture, particularly concerning sustainable food production in Europe. With a focus on sustainable practices and technological advancements, the workshop is set to bring together food industry experts, researchers, policy-makers, and farmers to exchange knowledge, share best practices, and foster collaboration in addressing water management issues in agriculture across all Members States.

Objectives of the event

- Identify current challenges and opportunities in water management within agricultural practices with a look at Controlled Environmental Agriculture.
- Explore innovative technologies and methodologies for optimizing water use efficiency in agriculture.
- Discuss policy frameworks and regulatory measures to promote sustainable water management practices in the agricultural sector and food production.
- Share successful case studies in the EU and beyond of water-efficient agricultural practices.
- Foster networking and collaboration among stakeholders to promote knowledge exchange and capacity building.
