A Digital Ecosystem for Circular Construction

How can **digital solutions** accelerate the transition to a circular economy in construction? And how do these tools fit best into the workflows of manufacturers, constructors, designers and engineers? These are the questions central to the **Reconstruct** project, co-funded by the European Union under the Horizon 2022 call.

On the table is a set of digital solutions, integrated through blockchain, to track and trace materials through the value chain, including product passports, building passports and 6D-BIM models for a data-driven (de)construction process. With new challenges to futureproof our buildings and close materials loops, these tools also provide the data necessary for informed decision-making, allowing clients and building professionals to assess and compare the impacts of different construction systems and material choices.

During our half-day stakeholder event in Brussels, the Reconstruct partners will present the first iteration of this ecosystem. Focusing on the role of data and digital tools in the European net zero agenda, we will showcase the data, formats and workflows developed.
